

Classification

Competitors will shoot their ESP CPSA classification as given to them on 1st March 2024. Unclassified competitors will be classified on the day over selected targets. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure they have been given the correct classification before they start their round.

Course

The sporting course will consist of 120 birds shot over 15 stands. Squads of 6 will head out every 10 minutes, starting from Stand 1. Three stands will be the Lyalvale Express Stands. Specific Lyalvale Express/Fiocchi/B&P cartridges must be used on these stands which the ground will supply.

There will be a referee on each stand.

A referee's decision is final. If a competitor does not agree with the decision, he or she is entitled to appeal to the shoot jury. The jury will consist of 4 team members, which will be published at reception each day.

Competitors must check in at least 15 minutes before their start time.

Once the event has begun no coaching or tuition from anyone will be permitted while the competitor is shooting the competition.

Prizes

In the case of a tie for High Gun, countback will be used from the final targets on Stand 12. We will continue to go backwards until a target is missed. Overall High gun is not eligible to win their class or category.

In the case of a tie for Classes and Categories, Add and Divide will be used. You are eligible to win a prize in both class and category.

Prizes to 6th place in AAA,AA,A,B,C. Prizes to 4th in Ladies, Juniors, Colts & Vets. Categories are the same as the CPSA cut offs for those categories. This prize breakdown is subject to the event reaching full entries.

Prizes will be issued via bank transfer.

Cartridges

Both Plastic and Fibre wad cartridges are allowed. Maximum load 28 Gram. 6.5 Shot.

On the Lyalvale Express stands, cartridges will be provided. If you do not wish to shoot with the specific cartridges your score will not be eligible to win any prizes. If you have a smaller calibre of gun, please let the ground know beforehand so cartridges can be arranged.

Cancellation

The event is subject to cancellation or rescheduling at the ground's discretion. In the event either of these do occur a communication will be sent to all competitors. If the event is cancelled, we will endeavour to return entry fees to you. If the event is rescheduled, you must make us aware straight away if you are unable to attend the rescheduled date.

Refunds

Refunds will be given if more than 48 hours' notice is given, less a £5 administration fee.

If less than 48 hours' notice is given, refunds will not be given.

Bookings

Pre booking is essential.

Bookings will be taken over the telephone from Tuesday 27th February 2024.

Full payment is required at time of booking. A confirmation email will be received shortly after booking, competitors must check the details are correct.

Spaces are filled on a first come first served basis. If all spaces are filled a communication will be published and a waiting list will be created.

Safety

Shotguns must be unloaded and ideally kept in slips while travelling between stands. When out of the slip, the gun depending on type, must be broken or in the case of a semi auto, have the chamber open or show a safety flag.

Guns may only be loaded when the competitor is in the stand.

As per ground rules we ask all competitors to wear a Hat, Eye Protection and Ear Protection

Liability

The organisers and landowners will not accept responsibility for the loss, damage or injury to persons, their property, vehicles or effects (including guns) while at the venue.
